

# Complimentary Practice Exam for PANCE

## Mapped to the 2019 PANCE Blueprint

Based on the 2019 NCCPA blueprint, Exam Master's Complimentary Practice Exam for the PANCE is designed to provide a realistic exam experience for new PA graduates preparing for the test. It covers all key topics found on the 2019 PANCE, including the new Professional Practice area.

285 of 300 items are mapped to each body system or domain. Each body system is covered accordingly to the NCCPA blueprint weighting, with cardiovascular being the dominant.

5% of the questions (15 total) on our practice exam cover Profession Practice which, together with the 285 body system questions, provide a total count of 300 questions, just like the actual exam.

Questions are further sub-divided into the important PA tasks:

We have also mapped all questions to Bloom's Taxonomy to make sure that strong emphasis is placed on the application of knowledge and high-level domains.
