Graduate Nursing Three Ps Readiness Exam

Exam Master's Graduate Nursing Three Ps Readiness Exam is designed to assess incoming graduate students in their undergraduate foundational knowledge of the Three Ps: Health Assessment (Physical), Pathophysiology, and Pharmacology prior to starting their advanced practice nursing courses. Table 1 displays the number of test items for each of the content areas.

Table 2 provides a breakdown of the number of questions in the Three Ps Readiness Exam by Bloom's Taxonomy cognitive levels. Many items are designed to test examinees' ability to apply their basic science knowledge to clinical science scenarios involving the Three Ps topics.
